BACKGROUND LEVEL: Child Care

JOB PURPOSE: Performs professional nursing, consultation, and educational services for persons with diabetes, and provides community health education.

JOB DUTIES:

- Educates clients to recognize warning signs, symptoms, and complications of diabetes.
- Develops curriculum on health, including research and production; acts as a health care consultant by providing information on the management of diabetes.
- Advises clients on the proper use of diabetic supplies, equipment, and readings.
- Assesses home care needs and conducts client health assessments.
- Makes home visits and monitors health status.
- Provides basic foot care in home and clinic settings.
- Develops, conducts and participates in health education activities, workshops or programs which promote healthy lifestyles for the general community or targeted groups.
- Performs health screening activities at health fairs, schools, and other community facilities.
- Facilitates Case Management Team with physicians.
- Oversees the patients care bringing any issues to the physicians attention.
- Provides referrals to other community services as needed.
- Facilitates Isleta Diabetes Support Group.
- Maintains confidential records and files and performs yearly audit.
- Performs other duties as assigned.
