EXECUTIVE ORDER 2025-04
ORDER LIFTING BURN BAN

WHEREAS, on May 2, 2025 the Pueblo enacted a Pueblo-wide BURN BAN which expressly prohibited certain open burn activities;

WHEREAS, on July 8, 2025 the Pueblo extended the effective date of the Pueblo-wide BURN BAN through August 31, 2025;

WHEREAS, the Pueblo has received beneficial rainfall and cooler weather since the adoption and extension of the BURN BAN Executive Order; and

WHEREAS, the Governor has considered the recent weather and determined that open burn activities no longer significantly threaten the community health and safety of Pueblo of Isleta residents and structures.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, effective immediately, the BURN BAN is hereby lifted;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, any burn activity remains strictly prohibited on designated NO BURN DAYS;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, unless it is a NO BURN DAY, the following burn activities are permitted:

1. Ditch, field, or yard burning;
2. Burning of trash of any kind;
3. Bonfires, campfires, stove fires or open flame charcoal grills/cooking fires; and
4. Agricultural burning.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, all individuals are required to receive a burn permit issued by the Department of Natural Resources prior to engaging in burn activities, and must call Isleta Dispatch on the day of burn activity;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, effective immediately, all burn permits issued by the Department of Natural Resources that were previously suspended due to the BURN BAN are hereby reinstated;


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Isleta Fire Department, Isleta Police Department, and Isleta Department of Natural Resources are hereby authorized and directed to do all that is necessary to enforce compliance with this Order; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that notice of this Executive Order shall be made to all interested parties and Tribal Members by:


- Providing electronic notice through the Pueblo of Isleta website and related social media;
- Providing notice through the Pueblo of Isleta text messaging system; and
- Posting notice at public locations within the Pueblo.

To the extent this Order may conflict with any other previously issued Order or directive, this Order shall supersede any other order, proclamation, or directives.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect until either rescinded or amended.
